From 2012 to 2024, he served as Associate Director and Clinical Professor in the Medical Humanities Program at Baylor University. Widely regarded as an authority on the role of social support in loss, Dr. Hoy believes

deeply in the importance of compassionate, community-based bereavement care. His extensive experience includes more than 20 years leading bereavement and pastoral care programs in hospice care.

In his post-Baylor career, Dr. Hoy continues to advise hospice bereavement programs and provides continuing education across the U.S. and Canada. He is active in the Association for Death Education & Counseling and contributes to the Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors and the Hospice Foundation of America. Additionally, Dr. Hoy is an accomplished author, with numerous articles and several influential books on bereavement care.
